ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

IMPORTANT HIGHLIGHTS OF ACTIVITIES

Nomination Forms for all Life Care prepared in consultation with Legal Counsel & sent to all Parents. Duly signed forms have been received and pending ones are being followed-up.

Our different activities converted into Projects with descriptions and cost calculations. These have been circulated to all Corporates for their Sponsorship / Support.

A one day Out Bound Training Programme was organised at Talegaon for MBA & SEFD Staff. An external Professional Trainer conducted the Programme. The Boarding & Lodging was sponsored by our Well Wisher Mr. Amit Dholakia. First time initiated and all the Staff really enjoyed the same as they found it interesting.

Students Appraisal Reports and Meeting with Parents completed both at Airoli & Sangharsh Nagar. Went off very well, especially in case of new Student Parents in Airoli and all Parents at Sangharsh Nagar.

This year, instead of Appraisals, we requested all Staff Members to write about the Foundation; their key success points and what are their thoughts about the Foundation for the future. Management has noted the key points and positives emanating from the different viewpoints. Instead of usual increments, a onetime ad hoc payment has been made to all Staff Members.

Third utility Centre at Sangharsh Nagar inaugurated. Good negotiations by the Team ensured we pay the same rent as is being paid to the two other facilities. This will take care of their requirements including the therapy sessions.

Additional wire fencing has been done on all the boundary walls as an additional safety precaution. This is sponsored by Mr Liku of Choudhary International, who is our well-wisher. The cost is approximately 2.25 lakhs.

During the period there were 112 Nos of enquiries.

- ⇒ Training in data entry work from one of the corporates has given the existing trainees a chance to showcase their skill in Computer & English. This can further be expanded to a job activity in future.

SUCCESS STORIES (Case Studies)



Daksh Shetty (Airoli)

Daksh is 5 years old. At the age of 3 years, he was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. When he joined us, we observed his attention span & social skills were very low. He is attention seeking and easily gets distracted. ADL skills and Speech not developed.

After complete assessment, his needs were identified as - one to one sessions for improving his attention span; Speech Therapy and Occupational Therapy (OT) for improving his speech and reduce his hyper activity.

Now after one year, his attention span has improved; his understanding level is much higher and now he can follow multiple instructions; therefore, parents were advised to admit him to a regular school, where he goes now and comes to us for therapy and special education ... while he is slowly picking up academic, he also likes to socialise. His earlier fear for any type of music has stopped and now he listens to all types of music.

In his sessions with us, we will be now focusing more on his functional academics and continue with his therapy sessions for further improvement.


Daksh is an ideal candidate for inclusion and we are helping & his parents with our support services.

Sahdev Dhuri is our Day care beneficiary admitted in Vocational training

MBA Foundation organized a free Assessment camp in October 2017, in which Sahdev was assessed. He was born with delayed milestones. He was diagnosed as a Slow learner with gross motor difficulty and low speech. He studied till 9th std in regular school, but could not complete his SSC.

He joined our foundation to develop his skills and was admitted in Vocational skills training. He is also learning social & emotional skills required for self confidence and now

he communicates with his teachers & peers. In Vocational training he has learnt to make Fancy paper Bags, Candles, Diya Painting, etc...



Sahdev also takes part in all Programmes of MBA like Music; Dancing; Yoga; Bhajans etc.
